Four Values

- Church leadership is to be exercised as a shared responsibility.
- Church leadership is meant to be empowered and directed by the Holy Spirit.
- Church leadership is first accountable to Jesus.
- Church leadership has been given three specific roles to fulfill.
 - a) Elder refers to their wisdom and experience; it is less about age and more about spiritual maturity. The role is expressed within the body through servant leadership.
 - b) Bishop/Overseer descriptive of their purpose; refers to protecting the flock against false teachers & divisive individuals or power seekers (vs. 29-31).
 - c) Shepherd/Pastor descriptive of their relationship with the body; their ministry is to imitate the way Jesus responds as the Shepherd to His flock.

Three Conclusions

- 1) We must be praying for our leaders to be listening to and obeying the Spirit of God.
- 2) Develop an elder selection process that is completely dependent on the Holy Spirit to appoint elders. (vs. 28)
- 3) Place yourself under the leaders the Holy Spirit has appointed.
