The Necessary Components

- 1. The purpose for the discipline process.
- The discipline process protects the purity and the peace of the body of Christ.

I am not overstating it when I say that the man who caused all the trouble hurt all of you more than he hurt me. (NLT)

- 2. The goal of the discipline process.
 - a) Go and admonish the offender in private
 - b) Bring one or two witnesses to continue to admonish the offender
 - c) Tell it to the church
 - d) Remove the unrepentant offender
- ❖ The goal of this process is repentance and restoration of the offender.
- 3. The posture for practicing the discipline process.
- The posture for practicing church discipline is humble submission to the authority of Jesus.
