STUDY QUESTIONS

1. What does it mean to have Jesus in your life?
2. Jesus is fully God and fully man. True God and true man. God of glory and power and suffering servant. What is your view of Jesus? Do you relate more to Jesus as meek servant or as conquering king?
3. Of all the titles of Jesus; Son of Man, King of Kings, Suffering Servant, High Priest, Lord, the Word, Prophet, etc. which one speaks to you the most? Which title do you often not think of Jesus being?
4. Throughout history many groups have denied either Jesus' divinity or his humanity. Which one does our culture today deny more often? So what should be our response to that as Christians?
5. Read John 1:1-18. Describe in your own words how Jesus of Nazareth is the Word.
6. Jesus is either Lord, a liar, or a lunatic. Who do you know that believes he is a liar or lunatic? How has this chapter helped give you the words to share the good news with them?
7. Dr. Kolb says that we can only confess the mystery of the personal union with God and man, we will never fully understand it. What do we believe about the mystery of Christ's presence in the Lord's Supper?

LIFE APPLICATION

Do an interview with someone who doesn't follow Jesus but is in your life. Tell them you are in a Life Group and the material is encouraging you to do this. Ask the following questions, not to respond to, or argue with, but just to gain understanding.

- Who do you think Jesus was?
- What experience have you had with a church? Positive or negative?
- What bible verses or books do you know?
- Would you mind if I described who Jesus is to me? (If they are willing to listen, tell them the good news!)
