BIBLE STORY

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BASIC TRUTH

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1. CHEF'S RELAY

WHAT YOU NEED: Chef's hat, pair of oven mitts, preschool-size apron, plastic bowl, plastic mixing spoon, play food, painter's tape, and an additional helper

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Use tape to mark a start and finish line approximately ten feet apart for your relay. Place the hat, mitts, and apron on the floor next to the start line. Place the play food inside the bowl. Place the bowl and spoon at the finish line. Ask children to line up in a single file line behind the start line.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Begin the relay by helping the first child in line put on the hat, mitts, and apron. Once dressed, encourage the child to run to the finish line, use the spoon to stir the food in the bowl, then run back to the start line. Help the child take off the props and help put them on the next child in line. Continue the relay by repeating the activity with each child. Repeat as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come over here to this tape line. I have a cooking relay game for us to play today! One at a time, we'll dress up like a chef, run to the bowl on the other side and give it a stir, then run back. Let's get cooking!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Let's get our first chef ready! [Child's name], are you ready? (Pause.) One, two, three, GO! Stir the food in the bowl! (Pause.) Fantastic! Now run back! (Pause.) Great job! We'll take your chef gear off and give it to the next chef in line! (Continue with each child.) That was fun watching everyone pretend to be chefs and quickly get to the food to stir it all up!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, in our Bible Story, we're going to hear how God knows everything about us! God even knows how much fun we were going to have playing our chef game today! Let's go hear all about it."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by pretending to stir a spoon in a bowl as you walk to the designated area.



2. WONDERFULLY MADE*

WHAT YOU NEED: "Allergy Alert Poster," "Wonderfully Made" Activity Page, cardstock, Play-Doh®, Play-Doh® Fun Factory extruder, laminating pouches, and baby wipes

*Note: Be sure to list the items you will be using today on the "Allergy Alert Poster" (in the Prelude folder) and post it at the door to your room.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock, list Play-Doh®, and post at the door. Copy "Wonderfully Made" on cardstock, one per child. Laminate each copy. Place on the table with small portions of Play-Doh® and the extruder.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to make a person by making eyes, nose, smile, ears, and hair. Help children use the extruder as needed.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come over here and look what we get to play with . . . Play-Doh! Let's use the Play-Doh to make a person!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "We can use this fun tool to make different fun shapes for hair. What color do you want to use for the hair? (*Put that color in the toy and show the child how to work it.*) Wow, that's really cool! Oh, your person needs eyes. What color are the eyes going to be? (*Pause.*) Let's give your person a nose too! (*Pause.*) And don't forget the ears! (*Pause.*) Now, let's make a happy smile. (*Pause.*) Look how amazing and wonderful your people look! Do any of the Play-Doh people look the same? (*Pause.*) No! These people all look different, but they all look wonderful!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Wow, friends! You did such a great job. I love the people's faces and hair that I see. In today's Bible Story, we're going to talk about how God made you and how important you are to Him!"

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by calling out a feature of each child. "God made [child's name] with bright brown eyes! God made [her/him] wonderful! God made [child's name] with an amazing laugh! God made [him/her] wonderful!" (Continue with each child.)

3. WONDERFUL HAIR

WHAT YOU NEED: Barbie® or other dolls with hair, hairbrushes, and combs

Note: Be sure to include diverse ethnicities, hair colors, and hair types (straight hair and curly hair).

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Place the dolls, brushes, and combs on the table.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to pretend to wash the dolls' hair, and then brush or comb and style the doll's hair.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Introduce the Bible Story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, look at all these beautiful dolls. Some have long hair, and some have short hair. Some have beautiful curls and others have beautiful straight hair."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Let's pretend to wash their hair. Think about what it's like to get your hair washed. Okay, now let's brush their beautiful hair. (*Pause.*) You are doing such a nice job! Give your doll a new hairstyle. (*Pause.*) Our doll friends have such beautiful hair, and you all did a wonderful job styling their it. Do you think you could count how many hairs your doll has? (*Pause.*) No, that would be hard! These dolls have so many strands of hair!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "In our Bible Story today, we are going to hear how God knows everything about us— even the number of hairs on our head! Let's go hear our story."

TRANSITION: Move to Worship and Story by asking all the friends with short hair to shout, "Wonderful!" Ask all the friends with curly hair to shout: "Wonderful!" Ask all the friends with long hair to shout: "Wonderful!"

1. SWEET VERSE

[HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Sweet Verse" Activity Page, cardstock, scissors, and plastic cake server

Note: You can find examples of hand motions in the "Memory Verse Hand Motions" PDF and video, included in the Prelude folder and on Pinterest.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Sweet Verse" on cardstock and cut, one set per Small Group. Spread the pieces of cake around the activity area. Review the Memory Verse and motions.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to find the six pieces of cake and help arrange them in order, matching shapes. When the cake is complete, say the Memory Verse and do the motions. Repeat as desired.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come stand with me. Let's say our verse and do the motions. Ready? 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) Great job!"

buring the activity: "Look, these papers look like pieces of cake! Let's see if we can put them all together to see what the message on the cake is. Here friend, (call the child's name) you can go first. This is a cake server. Pick up a piece of cake and let's see if we can figure out where it goes. (Pause.) Good start! [Child's name], take the cake server and select a different piece and see if we can put them together. (Continue until all the slices are in order.) Yay! What great helpers! You put the cake back together! Let me read the message on the cake. 'How you made me is amazing and wonderful.' Psalm 139:14. That's our Memory Verse! That's neat! Let's say our verse with the motions one more time. 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) Great job!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, God made each and every one of you wonderful! I'm so glad you are here today! Tell me: Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful! Let's say it one more time. Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful!"

2. NOODLE NAMES* [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Allergy Alert Poster;" cardstock; dry lasagna noodles; permanent marker; large, plastic bowl; and a large spoon

*Note: Be sure to list the items you will be using today on the "Allergy Alert Poster" (in the Prelude folder) and post it

at the door to your room.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock, list lasagna noodles, and post at the door. Break the noodles in half. Write each child's name on a piece of noodle with a permanent marker. Put all of the noodles with names written on them in a large bowl. Gather the children around the bowl.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Gently stir the noodles with the names on them one time with a spoon. Take one noodle out of the bowl. Show the name on the noodle to the children as you read it. Invite that child to stand while everyone says, "God made [child's name] wonderful!" The child will sit down as you set their name to the side. (You can also let each child hold their noodle until you play again.) Continue with each child.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Hey, everyone! Come sit with me! I have something very important in my mixing bowl."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "Would you like to see who is important to God? (Pause.) Okay, let me give my bowl a stir. (Gently stir the noodles one time, draw a noodle, and hold the name up.) It's a noodle and it has [child's name] on it! [Child's name] is important to God! Stand up, [child's name]! Everyone, let's tell [child's name] that God made [him, her] wonderful. One, two, three . . . 'God made [child's name] wonderful!' (Clap.) Yay! You can sit back down. Let's give our bowl another stir and see who else is important to God. (Continue doing this until every child's name has been drawn.) Did we call everyone's name? (Pause.) Yes! Because EVERYONE is important to God!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "You are important to God and God made you. God knows everything about you— even the number of hairs on your head! God made you wonderful! Who made you wonderful! God made me wonderful!"

WHAT YOU NEED: "Recipe of Wonder" Activity Page, cardstock, scissors, washable markers, and heart stickers

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Recipe of Wonder" on cardstock and cut, one card per child. Write each child's name on the blank at the top of their recipe card.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Give out the cards to the children. Lead the children to talk about the ways God made them wonderful using the dialogue below. Encourage them to draw a picture of themselves on the card and add heart stickers.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come sit with me. I have a recipe card for you to decorate."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "There are SO many wonderful things about you. Let's name some ways God made us wonderful! What about our hands? God made our hands, and they are wonderful. What about our eyes? God made our eyes, and they are wonderful! What else did God make? (*Pause for responses.*) I want you to draw a picture of yourself on your recipe cards! Then you can add some heart stickers because God made you with love! (*Pause.*) Wow! You drew amazing pictures of yourself!"



4. WE ARE SOUPER [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Round tablecloth and painter's tape

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Spread out the round tablecloth in an open space of the room. Secure the tablecloth to the floor with tape. Ask the children to stand around the edge.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Call each child by name to enter the "pot" and wiggle. Ask each child: "**Who made you wonderful?**" Encourage them to answer: **God made me wonderful!** When the pot is full, tell children to move around the pot when you stir. Ask all the children to jump out of the soup pot and say the Bottom Line together.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Hey friends, we are going to pretend this big circle is a soup pot. Can you find a spot around it? We are going to make friend soup!"

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "When I call your name, jump into the pot and wiggle around. [Child's name], jump in the bowl. God made you wonderful! [Child's name]: Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful! Great job! Stay in the pot and keep wiggling! (Repeat with each child.) Oh, look! Our pot is full! I'm going to stir the pot. When I say, 'stir,' move around the pot. Stir, stir, stir! Now when I say, 'jump,' everyone jump out of the pot. Jump! (Pause.) Shout: 'God made me wonderful!' God made me wonderful! Great job! Let's play again!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "That was so fun. It was so fun to call your names and tell you that God made you wonderful because God did make your wonderful! Who made you wonderful? God made me wonderful!"

5. CREATIVELY ME [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Creatively Me" Activity Page; cardstock; 9" x 13" baking sheets; washable paints in a variety of colors; paper plates; paintbrushes; cotton swabs; painter's tape; baby wipes; and a permanent marker

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Creatively Me" on cardstock, one per child. Write each child's name on their paper. Pour several colors of paint on each plate. Place baking sheets on the table upside down and place a piece of tape down the center of the baking sheet to create two 9" x 6 ½" workspaces.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to paint a picture of themselves, including their hair, on the back of the baking sheet in their designated area with any of the paint they desire. Help place their paper face down on the paint and gently press. Slowly lift the paper off to reveal their picture on the paper. Clean hands as needed. Wipe down the trays as needed to allow every child a turn.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Review the Bible Story and Bottom Line.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Friends, come find a seat at the table, and let's get creative!"

6. JOURNAL AND PRAYER [PRAY TO GOD | PRAYER ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Memory Verse Card" Activity Page from Week One in Bible, a journal, and a fun-shaped pen

Note: You can find examples of hand motions in the "Memory Verse Hand Motions" PDF and video, included in the Prelude folder and on Pinterest.

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: If you do not have the "Memory Verse Card" in your Bible, copy "Memory Verse Card" on cardstock and cut one per Small Group. Place one card in your Bible at Psalm 139:14. Keep this card in your Bible all month.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage the children to hold their hair out or touch their hair while you lead them to your Small Group spot. Sit down and gather the children around you. Review the Memory Verse and hand motions, then encourage the children to guess how many hairs are on their head while you write down what they say in the journal.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Pray with the children.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "It's Small Group time! Today, we're going to touch our hair while we walk to our Small Group spot. You can hold your hair out, or just lay your hand on your hair. Okay, friends, touch your hair and follow me! (Touch your hair as you lead the children to your Small Group spot.) We made it! Now let's sit down so we can talk about today's Bible Story. One, two, three, sit down with me!"

"In our Bible Story today, we learned that God knows everything about us. God even knows how many hairs are on your head! You are THAT important to God! So every time you look in the mirror, you are looking at someone important who is wonderfully made by God! That's why when I ask you, 'Who made you wonderful?' I want you to say, 'God made me wonderful!' Let's me hear you say it! Who made you wonderful! God made me wonderful!

"That's right! And the Bible verse we have been learning will help us always remember that how God made us is amazing and wonderful. It says, 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) Let's stand up and say that together. Just say what I say and do what I do. 'How you (point up) made me (point to self) is amazing and wonderful,' (push hands up twice) Psalm 139:14. (Open hands like a book.) I love saying that verse together!

(*Remember to print as you write in the journal, so the children can recognize their names and the letters.*)

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "These are some great guesses! We may not know exactly how many hairs are on our head, but God does! God knows everything about us because we are THAT important to Him! Would anyone like to pray before I pray? (Give each child who wants to pray the opportunity to do so.) "Dear God, thank You for teaching us how important we are to You. (Say each child's name) are all so important to You, that You even know how many hairs are on their head! Thank You that You made us amazing and wonderful and that You love us! We love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen."

Encourage preschoolers to enter the classroom and engage with peers and Small Group Leaders by providing fun, age-appropriate, hands-on activities that introduce new concepts they will hear in the Bible Story.
