THE WESLEY COVENANT PRAYER

“I am no longer my own, but thine.
Put me to what thou wilt, rank me with
whom thou wilt.

Put me to doing, put me to suffering.
Let me be employed by thee or laid aside for
thee,

Let me be full, let me be empty.

Let me have all things, let me have nothing.
I freely and heartily yield all things to thy
pleasure and disposal.

And now, O glorious and blessed God,
Father, Son, and Holy Spirit,
thou art mine, and I am thine. So be it.

And the covenant which I have made on
earth, let it be ratified in heaven. Amen.”

EXPLANATION OF THE WESLEY COVENANT PRAYER

John Wesley adapted this prayer from the Puritan tradition that was so important to his parents, Samuel and Suzannah, and life in the Epworth rectory. It informed his theology and preaching.

The prayer describes the life of a participant with Christ in his mission. It is a practical description of what Jesus was talking about when he said, “If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me” (Luke 9:23).

The Covenant prayer helps us remember what this Jesus-way of life looks like and what loving God with all our heart, soul, and mind and loving our neighbor as ourselves requires of us.

When we pray this prayer we remember that we are baptized. The Covenant Prayer describes missional life devoted to following Jesus and serving as Christ's representative in the world he loves and is working to redeem. It tells us that being a Christian is more a way of life than a system of beliefs. The Covenant Prayer describes the Jesus way of self-giving and self-emptying love.

You are invited to pray this prayer silently first. Then, I will ask us to pray it together aloud.
