#### **Seeds I Should Plant in My Family:**

Affection - the <u>outward expression</u> of love.

<u>Affirmation</u> – positive encouraging words

Neh. 9:17 "...you are a God of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, slow to become angry, and full of unfailing love and mercy."

#### Generosity

#### <u>Time</u>

Principle: I am not the only one planting seeds in my family.

<sup>1 Cor. 3:5</sup> "What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe - as the Lord has assigned to each his task. <sup>6</sup>I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. <sup>7</sup>So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. <sup>8</sup>The man who plants and the man who waters have one purpose, and each will

be rewarded according to his own labor. <sup>9</sup>For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building."
