Pt. 10 – Faithful in the Moment

Faithful: doing what honors God with an attitude that pleases God; doing right, for the right reasons, with a right attitude.

Success is being faithful, one moment at a time.

To determine what is faithful, ask myself:

1. How can I please God in this moment?
2. What is my assignment?
3. If I am not faithful, what are the possible consequences?
4. If I am faithful, what are the possible rewards?
5. What example am I setting for those who follow me?
6. Is my attitude right?

Principle: If my attitude is wrong, the joy is gone.

7. What do I want to remember about this moment?
8. How do I want this moment to be remembered by others?
9. What message will my faithfulness send to others?
10. How would Jesus handle this moment?

Phil. 2:5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: ⁶Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, ⁷but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death- even death on a cross! ⁹Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
