## Pt.10 – Faithful in the Moment

**Faithful:** doing what <u>honors</u> God with an attitude that <u>pleases</u> God; <u>doing</u> right, for the right <u>reasons</u>, with a right <u>attitude</u>.

Success is being faithful, one moment at a time.

## To determine what is faithful, ask myself:

- 1. How can I please God in this moment?
- 2. What is my <u>assignment</u>?
- 3. If I am not faithful, what are the possible consequences?
- 4. If I am faithful, what are the possible rewards?
- 5. What example am I setting for those who follow me?
- 6. Is my <u>attitude</u> right?

**Principle:** If my attitude is wrong, the joy is gone.

- 7. What do I want to remember about this moment?
- 8. How do I want this moment to be remembered by others?
- 9. What message will my faithfulness send to others?
- 10. How would Jesus handle this moment?

Phil. 2:5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: <sup>6</sup>Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, <sup>7</sup>but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup>And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death- even death on a cross! <sup>9</sup>Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and very tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
