Pt. 3 – Delay

Three words that will change my financial life:

Obey

Mal. 3:7 “You have a long history of ignoring my commands. You haven’t done a thing I’ve told you. Return to me so I can return to you,” says God of-the-Angel-Armies. “You ask, ‘But how do we return?’ ⁸“Begin by being honest. Do honest people rob God? But you rob me day after day. “You ask, ‘How have we robbed you?’ “The tithe and the offering -that’s how! ⁹And now you’re under a curse -the whole lot of you - because you’re robbing me. ¹⁰Bring your full tithe to the Temple treasury so there will be ample provisions in my Temple. Test me in this and see if I don’t open up heaven itself to you and pour out blessings beyond your wildest dreams.” (The Message)

Pay

Prov. 22:7 *The rich rule over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.* (NIV)

Delay

1. Delay the purchase.

Lk. 14:28 *But don’t begin until you count the cost. For who would begin construction of a building without first calculating the cost to see if there is enough money to finish it?*

Lk. 12:15 *Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions.*

2. Delay the upgrade.
3. Delay the raise.
