THE MARRIAGE YOU WANT STARTS IN YOUR MIND.

• Focusing on the negative will lead to CONFIRMATION BIAS.

Confirmation bias is the tendency to seek out and prefer information that supports our preexisting beliefs. As a result, we tend to ignore any information that contradicts those beliefs.

- 3. RELATIONSHIPS REQUIRE THE RIGHT TYPE OF COMMUNICATION. (GODLY COMMUNICATION)
 - Proverbs 12:17-18 | Ephesians 4:15 | Ephesians 4:29 | Proverbs 18:21
 - Speak the Truth in love!
 - Make sure you are depositing positive/life giving words so when you have to say something that is true but tough to hear, it will be received.



Before sharing the truth, ask these 3 questions?

- God, should I say it?
- When should I say it?
- How should I say it?

Community: Hebrews 10:24–25

- And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
- How do we live out our need for community at CGF? How can we personally commit to Hebrews 10:24-25?

Marriage: Matthew 19: 4–6

"Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.
