1. Love Leads to OBEDIENCE

15 “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

—John 14:15 (ESV)

2. His Love Leads to OUR LOVE

19 We love because he first loved us.

—1 John 4:19 (ESV)

9 In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. 10 In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

—1 John 4:9-10 (ESV)

3. Obedience Leads to the ENJOYMENT of His Love

10 If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.

—John 15:10 (ESV)
