**Maundy Thursday** is the beginning of the great three days—the ancient observance of the mystery of our redemption.

In these three days—through songs, scripture, liturgy, and preaching—the faithful participate in the death of Jesus and are brought with him to Resurrection life. The three days begin with one worship service, beginning on Thursday evening and concluding with the first Easter service.

Maundy Thursday worship focuses on three significant actions. First, the confession of sins and announcement of forgiveness brings to a conclusion the repentance of Lent. Second, the church obeys Jesus' command (in Latin, mandatum, from which this day receives its name) to love one another and wash each other's feet. Third, we celebrate our meal of deliverance, taking our place at the supper Jesus shared with his disciples on this night.

### Good Friday, April 15

At noon on Good Friday we will gather at the Outdoor Chapel for a service of quiet reflection and prayer. At 6:30pm on Good Friday we will gather in the Worship Space and reflect on the power of the cross.

## Easter Sunday, April 17

At 6:30am on Easter Sunday, we will worship at the Outdoor Chapel and greet the sunrise as we discover the joy of Easter.

At 10:00am we will worship in the Worship Space for a joyful service of celebration.
