PSALM 133:1

Do to others as you would have them do to you Luke 6:31



READ THE FOLLOWING SCRIPTURES:

Sometimes when you spend all day, every day, with the same people, things can begin to irritate you and relationships can sometimes get more difficult. As we read in the Bible, family is very important to God. He gives us families to bless us and give us balance. Nobody knows us better than our family, and nobody loves us more than our family (except Jesus!). This is a fantastic opportunity to develop our relationship with our family. Make the most of it by doing activities with them, going for walks, playing games, learning to cook, doing some baking...go crazy!



GET CREATIVE...

Make a list of ways you can be a blessing to your family.

- **Examples:** \star Clear the table after dinner
 - Offer to tidy your siblings' room
 - K Help make dinner one night

... then once your list is complete, do them!

TIME FOR A GAME...

Hunt the button. Everyone leaves the room whilst the player hides a button in that room. Everyone then comes back into the room and tries to find the button. The player may give clues such as 'hotter' and 'colder'. The winner is the person who finds the button first – they may then hide the button next. If you don't have a button, you could use something else that is hide-able, such as a hair clip.



Here's something extra... find a pack of cards and ask someone in your family to play a game. If you don't know any card games or would like to learn a new one, ask a grown up to find some instructions on the internet (examples include Go Fish, Cheat, Snap and Rummy).



Ask God to help you develop your relationships with your family. Ask Him to help you love them even when they irritate you and ask Him to help you be a blessing to them.
