





ECCLESIASTES 4:10





READ THE FOLLOWING SCRIPTURES:

- Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor. If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.- Ecclesiastes 4:9-10
- Greet Priscilla and Aquila, my co-workers in Christ Jesus. They risked their lives for me. Not only I but all the churches of the Gentiles are grateful to them. -Romans 16:3-4



In Romans 16:3-4, Paul instructs the church in Rome to 'greet Priscilla and Aquila'. Although Paul didn't see his friends very often due to his travels, they remained in his heart and in his prayers. At the moment we can't see our friends, however that doesn't mean we stop thinking about them or praying for them. Now more than ever we need our friends to encourage one another and build each other up.




LET'S TALK TO GOD...




