MINISTRY FOCUS - FAMILY PROMISE



OUR CURRENT SERMON SERIES

This series is inspired by the book, Wesleyan Vile-tality by Ashley Boggan, and the new vision statement of the United Methodist Church. John Wesley, an Anglican priest who would become the founder of the Methodist movement, wrote in a journal entry from April 2, 1739, describing his decision to preach outside of a church, as: "I submitted to be more vile." In other words, Wesleyan vile-tality is a willingness to look beyond today's acceptable practices and



norms, and bend the rules in order to ensure that more people can experience the love of God. This journey back to the heart of Methodism challenges us to live fully into today's new UMC vision statement by loving boldly, serving joyfully, and leading courageously with Jesus in the lead!
