Main Idea:

If He is to be preeminent in everything how much more should He be preeminent in the church

When you come together

Text:

You will know them by their pursuit

1Corinthians 14:26 ¶ What then, brothers? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up.

1 cor 12:7; 14:1-12 (Paul is showing them what a Spirit-filled church looks like (you will know them by their pursuit - built up)
eph 4:9-16 (A Spirit filled church without a Spirit-filled pursuit of maturity is not a Spirit-filled church)
Titus 1:5-11 (why would anyone minimize progressive revelation - you will know them by their pursuit)
Jn 3:25-4:3 (Jesus knew that the goal was not our self expression but a broader story arc...
jn 4:20-24 (our goal is not mere sincerity without truth - that is ignorance on fire at best)
1 Tim 3:14-16 (we are here to tell one story...and it is not yours)

You will know them by their fruit

1Corinthians 14:27 If any **speak** in a tongue, let there be only two or at most three, and each in turn, and let someone interpret.

1Corinthians 14:28 But if there is no one to interpret, **let each of them keep silent** in church and **speak** to himself and to God.

1Corinthians 14:29 Let two or three prophets **speak**, and let the others weigh what is said.

1 Corinthians 14:30 If a revelation is made to another sitting there, **let the first be silent**.

1Corinthians 14:31 For you can all prophesy one by one, **so that all may learn and all be encouraged**,

1Corinthians 14:32 and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets.

1Corinthians 14:33a For God is not a God of confusion but of peace.

matt 7:15-20 (you will know them by their fruit)
matt 23:5-12 (they loved their own glory recognition - titles)

James 1:19; 3:1-18 (their problem was not sincerity but selfishness- presumptive speaking for the Lord, disorder...)
gal 5:19-26 (a Spirit-filled church without Spirit-filled fruit of self control is not a Spirit filled church)
rom 15:1-6 (we are here to tell one story, with one voice...to bring One glory)

You will know them by their dispute

1 Corinthians 14:33b As in all the churches of the saints,

1Corinthians 14:34 **the women should keep silent** in the churches. For they are not permitted to **speak**, but should be in submission, as the Law also says.

1 Corinthians 14:35 If there is anything they desire to learn, let them ask their husbands at home.

For it is shameful for a woman to speak in church.

1Corinthians 14:36 ¶ Or was it from you that the word of God came? Or are you the only ones it has reached?

1Corinthians 14:37 If anyone thinks that he is a prophet, or spiritual, he should acknowledge that the things **I am writing to you are a command of the Lord**.

1Corinthians 14:38 If anyone does not recognize this, he is not recognized.

1Corinthians 14:39 So, my brothers, earnestly desire to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in tongues.

1Corinthians 14:40 But all things should be done decently and in order.

1 Tim 2:8-15 (what is cultural/universal? - you will know them, by their dispute - Word or culture) Jude 3, 17-20 (a Spirit filled church with no Spirit-filled dispute of what is false is not a Spirit-filled church) rev 2:1-7 (you will know them by their pursuit (1-4), by their fruit (5), and by their dispute (6-7) col 1:15-20 (implication/application)
