1 Corinthians 2:10b "The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. ^{11.} For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God." (NIV)
Luke 18:35 "As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. ^{36.} When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. ^{37.} They told him 'Jesus of Nazareth is passing by.' ^{38.} He called out, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!'" (NIV)
