STORY 1 // RETURNING BACK TO NAZARETH (Mark 6:1-6)

This event gives us a window into how important it is to have Kingdom dreams for the next generation rather than strictly cultural dreams. An absence of a Kingdom dream leads to the next generation giving their lives to something smaller than God desires.

STORY 2 // A MOTHER'S DEMENTED REQUEST (Mark 6:21-29)

This event gives us a window into how important it is to point the next generation in the right direction rather than unintentionally (and sometimes intentionally) leading them down the wrong path by emphasizing and impressing upon them the wrong things.

SUNDAY RECAP
