GETTING STARTED

SUNDAY RECAP

"As he was setting out on a journey, a man ran up, knelt down before him, and asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" // Mark 10: 17 (CSB)

Have you ever had to ask someone that you love deeply to do something extremely difficult? In this week's message we observe an encounter between Jesus and a young wealthy man. The man has great intentions to follow Jesus and yet there was something holding him back from fully living for God. Jesus isn't interested in our claims of doing all of the right things. The truth was he was holding back what was the young man's true heart's desire. For everyone who desires to follow Jesus there will be a different sacrifice involved. What you hold on to will ultimately take hold of you and keep you from a life of faith in Jesus.

1. Read and reflect on Mark 10:17-22. What do these verses teach us about the heart of Jesus? How did the passage relate to this week's message and how can you apply it to your life?

2. What has God called you to give up in your life in order to follow

3. Read and reflect on Mark 10: 23-31.

What do you find your identity in? What are some ways you can keep your identity in Christ?

"Yes," Jesus replied, "and I assure you that everyone who has given up house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or property, for my sake and for the Good News, will receive now in return a hundred times as many...along with persecution. And in the world to come that person will have eternal life. But many who are the greatest now will be least important then, and those who seem least important now will be the greatest then." Mark 10: 29-31 (NLT)
