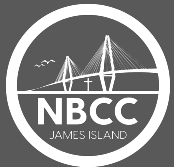

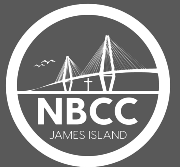

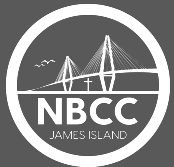
The Preeminence of Christ

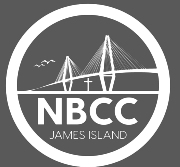
He existed before anything was created

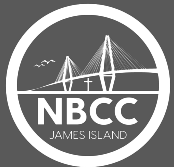
for through him God created everything

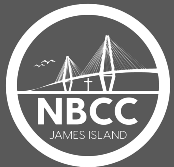
Shout with joy to the LORD, all the earth!
