Hebrew is there ever was one!

**Philippians 3:5**

I was a member of the Pharisees, who demand the strictest obedience to the Jewish law.

**Philippians 3:5**

I was so zealous that I harshly persecuted the church. And as for righteousness, I obeyed the law without fault.

**Philippians 3:6**

I once thought these things were valuable,  
but now I consider them worthless because  
of what Christ has done.

**Philippians 3:7**

**Yes, everything else is worthless when  
compared with the infinite value of knowing  
Christ Jesus my Lord.**

**Philippians 3:8**

For his sake, I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ and become one with him.

---

**Philippians 3:8 - 9**

I no longer count on my own righteousness  
through obeying the law;  
rather, I become righteous through faith in  
Christ.

---

**Philippians 3:9**

For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith.

---

**Philippians 3:9**

I want know Christ and experience the  
mighty power that raised him from the  
dead.

---

**Philippians 3:10**

I want to suffer with him, sharing in his  
death,

---

**Philippians 3:10**

So that one way or another I will experience  
the resurrection from the dead!
