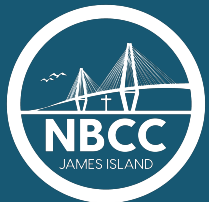
Lessons from Proverbs 4

Pay attention and learn good judgment,



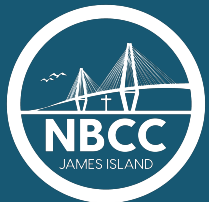
Proverbs 4:1 (NLT)

tenderly loved as my mother's only child.



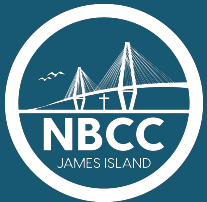
Proverbs 4:3 (NLT)

and you will have a long good life.



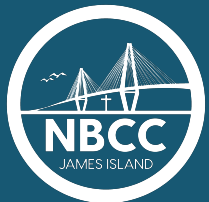
Proverbs 4:10 (NLT)

Let them penetrate deep into your heart,**



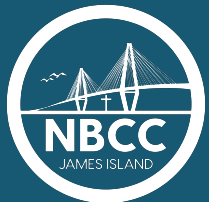
Proverbs 4:21 (NLT)

and healing to their whole body.



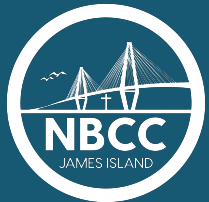
Proverbs 4:22 (NLT)

for it determines the course of your life.



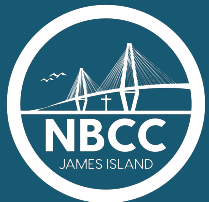
Proverbs 4:23 (NLT)
