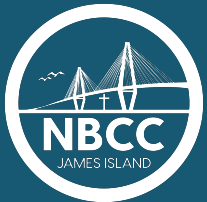

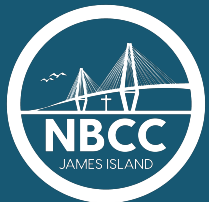
Yes, I am the gate. Those who come in through me will be saved. They will come and go freely and will find good pastures.

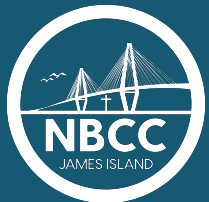

looking for someone to devour.**



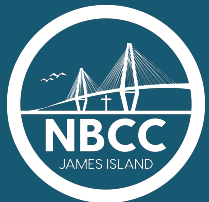
**1 Peter 5:8 (NLT)**

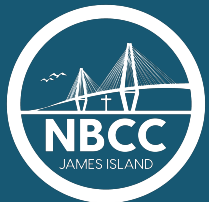


While I was at the window of my house,

seductively dressed and sly of heart.



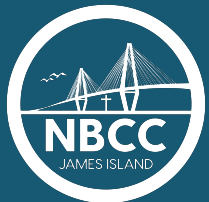
Proverbs 7:10 (NLT)

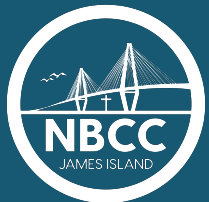


Follow my advice, my son;

own eyes.**



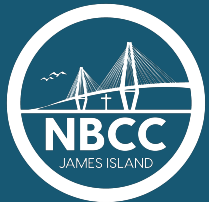
**Proverbs 7:2 (NLT)**
