And sure enough, Pharaoh heard what had happened, and he tried to kill Moses.






<u>One day</u> Moses was tending the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian.

"I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob."






"Now go, for I am sending you to Pharaoh. You must lead my people out of Egypt."

God answered, "I will be with you. And <u>this is your sign</u> that I am the one who has sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt -






You will worship God at this very mountain."

Exactly two months after the Israelites left Egypt, they arrived in the wilderness of Sinai.


Exodus 19:1 (NLT)
