


Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea, and they went out into the wilderness of Shur;




and they went three days in the wilderness and found no water.

Exodus 15:23 (NASB)




For that reason it was named Marah.

And he threw it into the waters, and the waters became sweet. There He made for them a statute and regulation, and there He tested them.


