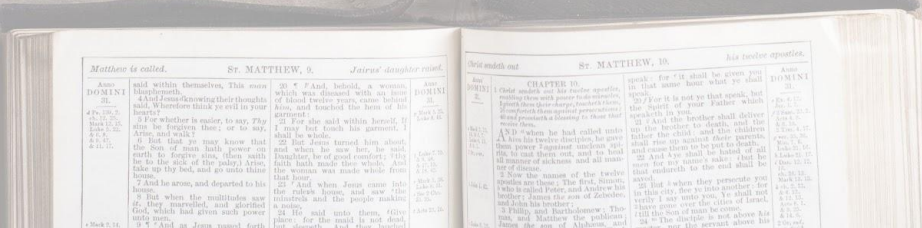
The New Testament reveals the 'New Covenant'; the key to understanding new life is understanding the new covenant.

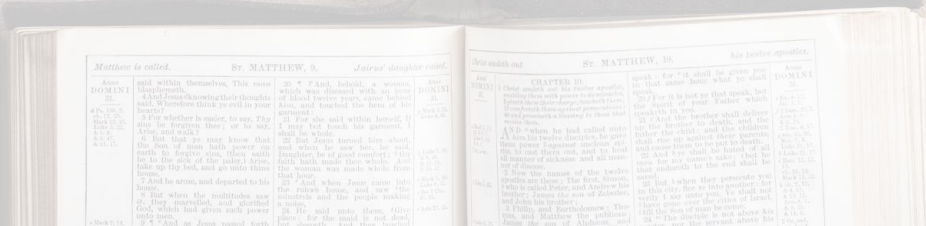

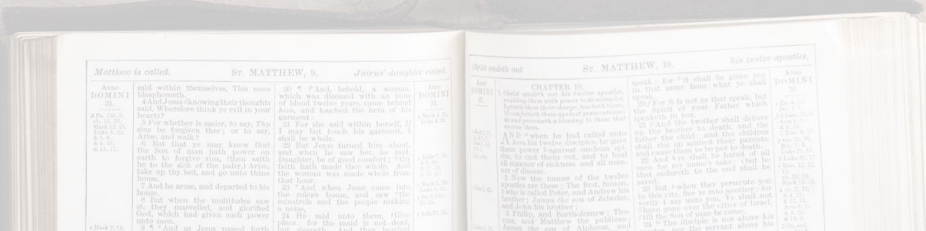
Hebrews 8:1 (NLT)

Here is the main point:
We have a High Priest who sat down in
the place of honor beside the throne of
the majestic God in heaven.



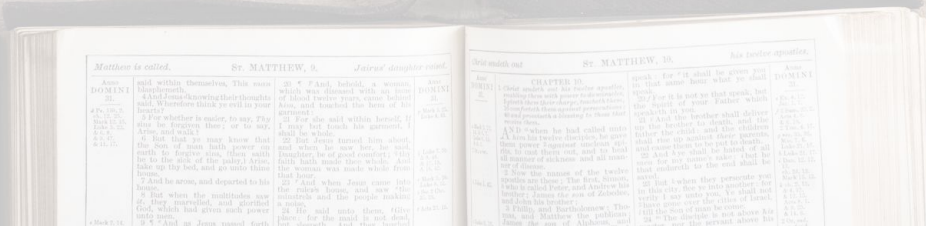
Hebrews 8:2 (NLT)

There he ministers in the heavenly Tabernacle, the true place of worship that was built by the Lord and not by human hands.

For by that one offering he forever made perfect those who are being made holy.



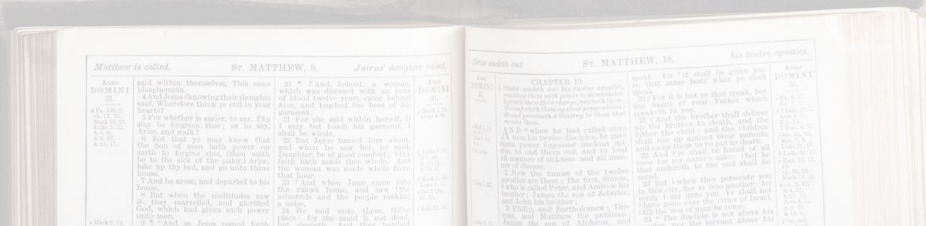
Hebrews 8:6 (NLT)

But now Jesus, our High Priest, has been give a ministry that is far superior to the old priesthood, for he is the one who mediates for us a far better covenant with God, based on better promises.



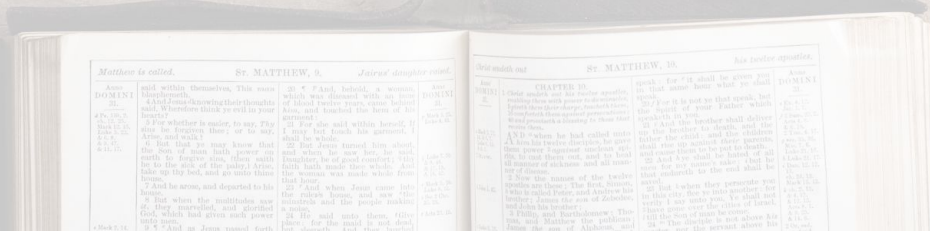
Hebrews 8:7 (NLT)

If the first covenant had been faultless, there would have been no need for a second covenant to replace it.



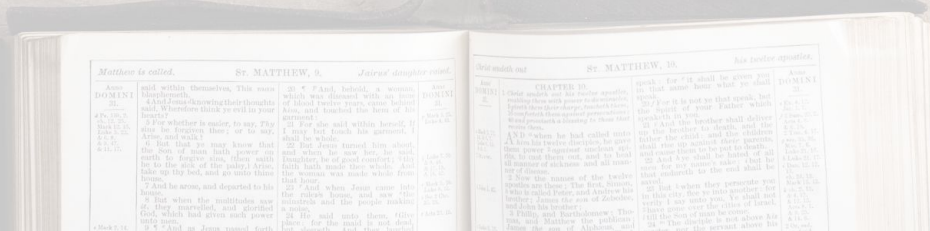
Exodus 20:1 (NLT)

Then God gave the people all these instructions:



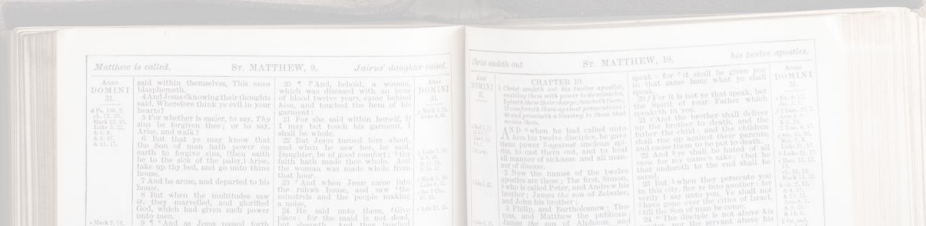
Exodus 20:3 (NLT)

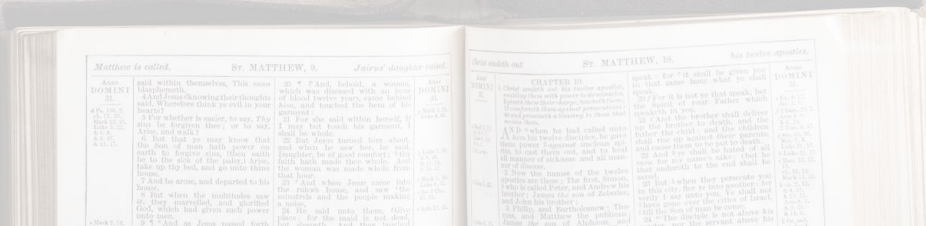
Exodus 24:7 (NLT)

But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel on that day, says the LORD:



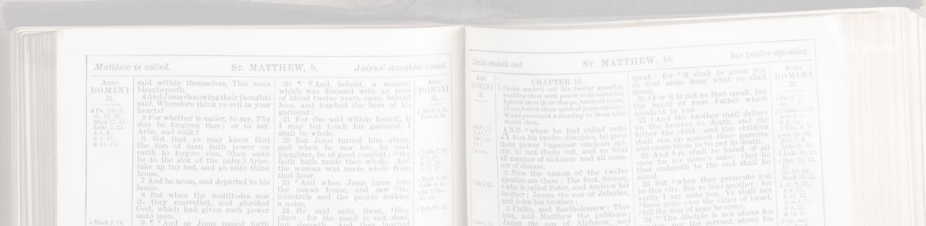

people.



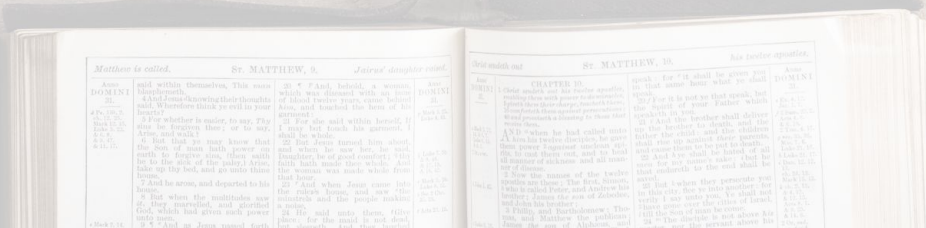
Hebrews 8:11 (NLT)

When God speaks of a “new” covenant, it means he has made the first one obsolete. It is now out of date and will soon disappear.



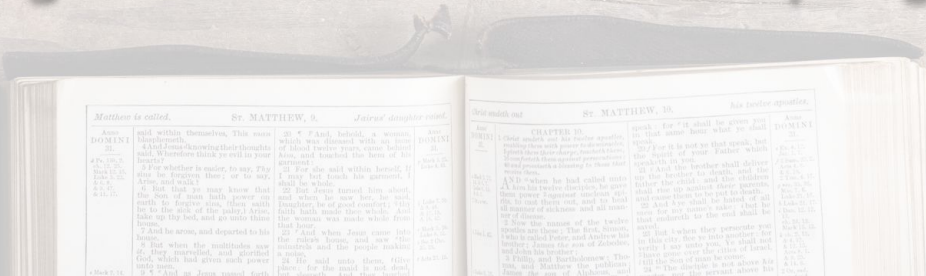

And gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.”



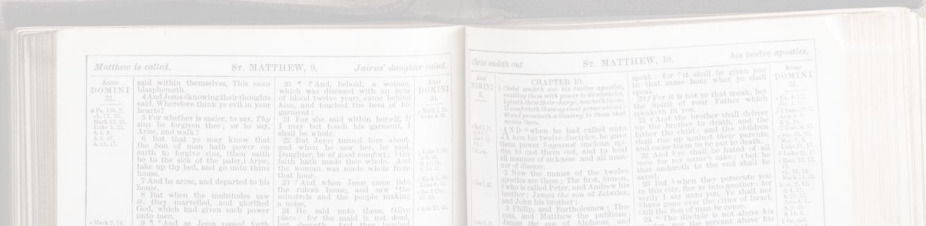

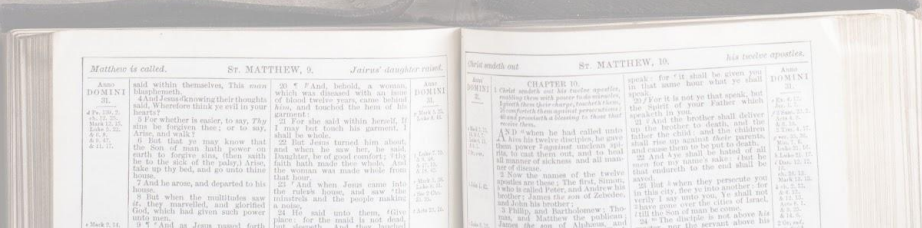
