Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Paul calls for the church to walk worthy of their position in Christ, but is not calling the church to walk and MAKE themselves worthy. Do you find that you struggle with this, thinking that you have to now strive to be worthy in your walk with Christ?
- 2. The church is unified as people walk in lowliness and gentleness. What are some practical ways this can be accomplished in the local church?
- 3. The church is also unified when long-suffering is exercised. When have you extended long-suffering to another believer? When have you experienced long-suffering personally?
- 4. What are some examples from the life of Jesus that exhibited these attributes of walking that Paul describes in verses 2-3?

This week, re-read Ephesians 4:1-6 and pray through the truths you find while reading. Find someone to discuss these verses with, and share the word with someone you don't know as well.
