Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Timothy's fear and timidity probably kept him from doing all that God had called him to do. Have you ever experienced fear that stagnated your working for the Lord? How did you overcome it?
- 2. Who in your life do you have that encourages you like Paul does for Timothy?
- 3. As Timothy was bold in the Lord, he would also be unashamed of the gospel message he shared. Do you think this could be the same for you as you lean into the Lord, and seek boldness and power from Him?
- Paul was honest with Timothy that he needed to be unashamed in suffering for Christ. What do you think suffering for the Lord could look like if you live in a way that is unashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

This week, re-read 2nd Timothy 1:6-18 and pray through the truths you find while reading. Find someone to discuss these verses with, and share the word with someone you don't know as well.
