



**Why is Beast Tech a Thing? Part 1
Some Truth About the Devil He is all About Deception
Revelation 12:3-4**

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As we study the scriptures, especially in relation to the Tribulation, we discover that technology is a much larger factor than we would ever consider as an enabler for the reign of the Beast and the false trinity of Satan that we read of in Revelation 13.



And there is one other thing we must keep in mind as we begin our look into this topic of last days tech enabling the Beast and Satan. The enemy is a liar and a deceiver, and he is already using the technology to spread his lies and deception as far and wide as possible.

The enemy has also successfully become part of the church, in some cases leading entire denominations down the drain. Much of this modern deception though began two centuries ago in the seminaries of the time. As we discuss the enemy, we will also find that we will discuss demonology.

In the world of the unseen realm, we have the heavenly host, and of those who were created by the Lord and dwell there. There are those who are faithful and there are those who are no longer faithful and are in a fallen state, they are referred to as evil spirits.

Evil spirits are members of God's heavenly host who have chosen to rebel against his will. Passages such as 1 Kings 22:19–23 make it clear that "the members of God's heavenly host are spirits (Hebrew: rūḥōt; singular: rūḥ)—entities that, by nature, are not embodied, at least in the sense of our human experience of being physical in form." (Heiser 2020, 6)

Yes, we are indeed talking about supernatural beings and one of the assumptions the Bible makes is we take the existence of this realm as a truth from God's word, it is real. Dr. Unger though points out why we have discomfort on this topic.

"The qualification of "evil" further complicates the matter and makes any naturalistic approach doubly hazardous. The powers to be dealt with are not only above the natural realm, and hence wiser and more powerful than man in the natural realm, but they are "evil." **They are desirous and able to deceive and lead astray. They resent light, for they are in darkness. They fight against the truth, because they are in error and rebellion against God, and truth glorifies God.** Any naturalistic attempt to discover truth in the realm of the divine revelation, however sincere or scientific it may be, is inevitably foredoomed to failure and deception. **The natural man, unprotected and unguided by God's Spirit, not only cannot "receive" or "know" matters which pertain to the Spirit of God (I Cor. 2:14), but he is actually subject to limitless error and perversion, as a prey to seducing spirits and doctrines of demons (I Tim. 4:1).** (Unger 1994, Kindle location 157)

Luke 24:37–39

"But they were startled and frightened and thought they saw a spirit. And he said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? See my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me, and see. For a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."" (ESV)

As a spirit, they are multidimensional, for now. I do believe that ends when they are cast out of heaven in Revelation 12:12. But we also know they can manifest as a human (Hebrews 13:2, Genesis 19:1).

In our limited time together, I am not able to dive deeply into this, but it is a topic, supernatural intelligent evil, which many of us have held, at one time or another or even at present, ideas about which are filtered through church traditions rather than the word of God.

Most English translations use the term "demon" three times in the Old Testament (Lev 17:7; Deut 32:17; Ps 106:37). Christian readers might wonder why demons are mentioned so infrequently in the Old Testament compared to the New Testament Gospels. But that very question erroneously presumes that the "demons" of the Old Testament are the same as those encountered in the Gospels. They are not. (Heiser 2020, xvi)



And the really big assumption that we deal with today, and it has even developed its own set of false teachings connected with it, is that fully 1/3rd of all of the heavenly host fell at once as a result of the fall in Genesis 3, or worse, that they all fell prior to the creation of humankind.

This leads to the false ideas about pre-Adamic races, don't go there. Or the existence of a gap between Genesis 1:1 and 1:2, famously referred to as the Gap Theory in response to Darwin and the Theory of Evolution. This alleged gap was millions or billions of years of years in length cannot be defended Biblically at all.

2 Peter 3:3–7

“Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts, and saying, “Where is the promise of His coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue just as they were from the beginning of creation.” **For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water, through which the world at that time was destroyed by being flooded with water. But by His word the present heavens and earth are being reserved for fire, kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly people.**” (NASB 2020)

In 2 Peter 3:5–7, we might expect to find a statement that God had destroyed a once perfect creation prior to Genesis 1 because in this passage Peter is speaking about God's destruction of the heavens and the earth. But he mentions only two judgments of the universe: (1) when God destroyed it by a flood in the past, and (2) when God will destroy it by fire in the future. (Walke 1975, 143)

The only place we see the number of fallen ones is in Revelation 12:4.

Revelation 12:3–4

“Then another sign appeared in heaven: and behold, a great red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and on his heads were seven crowns. And his tail swept away a third of the stars of heaven and hurled them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her Child.” (NASB 2020)

But here is the thing, we all tend to think that sin originated at the fall, but prior to the fall, there was a divine being named Lucifer, who began harboring inflated ideas of his own self-worth.

As we begin to look at this individual, who is identified by name for us, star of the morning, son of dawn, Helel Ben-Sahar, we need to refamiliarize ourselves with the whole world of ideas connected with this fallen divine being who we also know by the name of Lucifer, the Serpent, and in the New Testament, as Satan, the Devil or the Dragon.

As a member of the heavenly host, he was created. He has not existed eternally and he, as well as none of those members of the heavenly host, have the attributes of God.

Nehemiah 9:6

““You are the LORD, you alone. **You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them; and you preserve all of them; and the host of heaven worships you.**” (ESV)

Colossians 1:16

“**For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.**” (ESV)



What is true of all creatures relative to the power they exert, is equally true of the angels: their power is derived from God. Their power, however great, is restricted. They are unable to do those things which are peculiar to Deity—create, act without means, or search the human heart. They may influence the human mind as one creature may influence another. The knowledge of this truth is of great importance when, as later, contemplation will be given to the ascendancy evil spirits may assume over human beings. It will be found that human beings are able to thwart the influence of evil spirits only by divine enablement (Eph. 6:10–12; 1 John 4:4). Even an angel may claim divine assistance when in conflict with another angel (Jude 1:9). (Chafer, Systematic Theology 1993, 15-16)

And evil spirits, are engaged in combat operations against the rest of the heavenly host (Daniel 10:13, 20). Evil spirit, the fallen ones, both of the heavenly host as well as the demonic realm, are all defeated right now as a direct result of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Colossians 2:15

“He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.” (ESV)

Back to Lucifer though, Dr. Pentecost relates that “When God created Lucifer, God created him with a capacity to reflect the glory of God to a greater degree than any other created being. All of the beauty that was seen in this highest of angelic beings was a beauty that was given to him by creation, not a beauty that was innately his own. It was a reflected beauty. God in His holiness was the light that made Lucifer radiate and scintillate the glory that was His. It could be said that Lucifer was perfect in beauty, for no creature so fully reflected the glory of God.” (Pentecost 1997, 16)

Isaiah 14:12–15

“How you have fallen from heaven, You star of the morning, son of the dawn! You have been cut down to the earth, You who defeated the nations! But you said in your heart, ‘I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will make myself like the Most High.’ “Nevertheless you will be brought down to Sheol, To the recesses of the pit.” (NASB 2020)

What if Moses had considered that the glowing of his face due to being in the presence of YAHWEH (Exodus 34:29-32) was due to his own righteousness rather than that of the Father? I am sure that Lucifer experienced the same results that Moses did once his access ended.

We also see in Isaiah 14:12 that Lucifer is the one ultimately responsible for the misapplication of administrative power to the nations of the world.

The Lord holds all the corrupted members of the divine council personally accountable (Psalm 82:6-7) for the failures that took place post Genesis 11, but it appears here that He is letting us know that the original idea was from Lucifer.

When you also consider the actions in the Great Tribulation involving the nations, it also makes sense. The word for weaken can also mean vanquish.

And did you also notice this in our passage from Isaiah, the crimes listed, were thought crimes. “But you said in your heart.”

And one of those things he said in his heart was “I will sit on the mount of the assembly in the recesses of the north.” “This statement goes way beyond wanting to have ultimate control of the Heavenly Host, here “Lucifer expressed a desire to control all the affairs of the universe.”” (Pentecost 1997, 23)



The secret purpose in his heart reveals his method to be, not a violent attack upon the throne: but, like Absalom's, to steal the hearts of the unfaithful in the kingdom, and, through subtlety, to gain a government. He would thus become an object of worship, and attract attention from other beings to himself. To accomplish this, a hindering attitude must be assumed toward the purpose and projects of the Most High. (Chafer, Satan 1909)

And in Revelation 12, after being cast out of the heavenlies he is limited, as are all those who he convinced to rebel along with him, are limited to the first heaven, that would be earth.

Revelation 12:7–9

“And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war, and they did not prevail, and there was no longer a place found for them in heaven. And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.” (NASB 2020)

The second heaven is the heaven of interstellar space. Helel already had access to the third heaven. He was a throne guardian. He worked there. He, like all the other heavenly hosts, had access but it was not their primary home.

“Lucifer was not desiring to spend more time as one of the cherubim ministering before the throne of God. He who came there to minister by divine permission desired to abide there as God abode there eternally. He who came to the presence of God wanted to make himself equal with God. The creature desired to expel the Creator. The one who came into being by the word of God wanted to move God off His throne and occupy that throne as though it were rightfully his.” (Pentecost 1997, 22)

So, as a created spiritual being, now limited to the physical realm of earth and losing the multidimensionality you used to enjoy, now you are limited to a world where you will need to have technology to obtain for you what you used to be able to obtain rapidly by passing from one place to another. That is gone and the clock is ticking.

Does the enemy know what is in the scriptures? Yes, better than you and I do. So, what will they have to have to create the illusion of godhead with Satan, the Beast and the False Prophet as the counterfeit trinity? Technology. Quantum computers, sure but more so, AI. Are we talking artificial general intelligence or the step beyond that. And what about all the upgrading of humanity talk as well? That too. John Lennox tells us what the reality is.

“The quest for upgrading humans, creating superintelligence and godhood, is very ancient and, in its contemporary form, dressed up in the language of advanced computer technology, very alluring. The project sounds like the culmination of billions of years of development, initially blind and natural and finally directed by the human mind to which those evolutionary processes gave rise. Yet at its heart, it delivers a flawed narrative that is neither true to the past nor to the nature of reality. Indeed, its narrative is the reverse of what actually is the case. Superintelligence and godhood are not the end products of the trajectory of the history of human ingenuity. If there is a God who created and upholds the universe and who made us in his image, then a superintelligence, God himself, has always existed. He is not an end product. He is the producer.” Not the Beast, or Satan, or anyone else. (Lennox 2024, 249)

Jesus Christ came to this planet as the perfect man and He was also God at the same time. Satan will try and counterfeit this with the application of cybernetics, genetic engineering and technology. We already know a couple of the results. Impersonation.



Revelation 13:3–8

“One of its heads seemed to have a mortal wound, but its mortal wound was healed, and the whole earth marveled as they followed the beast. And they worshiped the dragon, for he had given his authority to the beast, and they worshiped the beast, saying, “Who is like the beast, and who can fight against it?” And the beast was given a mouth uttering haughty and blasphemous words, and it was allowed to exercise authority for forty-two months. It opened its mouth to utter blasphemies against God, blaspheming his name and his dwelling, that is, those who dwell in heaven. Also it was allowed to make war on the saints and to conquer them. And authority was given it over every tribe and people and language and nation, and all who dwell on earth will worship it, everyone whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slain.” (ESV)

Remember what Satan said there in the Garden, “you can be like God.” That is the whole goal of transhumanism. Satan planted the lie then and it is still believed today that God is against us, hardly, Jesus Christ and His work on the cross proves that to be false.

Jesus rose from the dead, ascended to the Father and is coming back soon to get us. John Lennox tells us “Jesus’ mind was not uploaded onto silicon; he ascended bodily into heaven and so, one day, will those who follow him. This claim clashes head-on with the dominant earthbound, atheistic naturalism of the Western academy that teaches that this world is all that there is; there is no other world to which one can ascend. But as I have repeatedly argued elsewhere, naturalism is not true, and contrary to widespread opinion, it is not supported by science; rather, it undermines it, since it can give no rational account of rational thought. The promises of AGI are firmly rooted in this world, and in that sense they are parochial and small compared with the mind-boggling implications of the resurrection and ascension of Jesus. (Lennox 2024, 263)
