Title: Why God Saved the Earth Through the Ark of His Son

Scripture: Heb. 11:6-7; Genesis 6-8:1; 1 Peter 3:18-22

2026 Theme Verses *May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God. **Romans 15:5-7***

April Verse: *And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him. **Heb 11:6***

Decision 1 - I will seek the Lord on His terms. (Heb. 11:6)

Decision 2 - I will hear and believe the Word of God. (Heb. 11:7)

Action point 1: Read the Bible for yourself. (Gen. 6:1-22)

- Wickedness in men was GREAT on the earth. (vs. 5, 11)
- God was grieved over the sin and wickedness of man. (vs. 5-6)
- God would perfectly and lovingly judge the earth by sending a global flood. (vs. 7,13,17)
- God found Noah blameless because Noah heard God and believed God. (vs. 8-9, 22)
- God told Noah to build the ark He would use to save all who put their faith in Him. (vs. 14-21)

Decision 3 - I will obey God and take the deliverance that God offers me. (Genesis 7:1-8:1)

- Noah followed God's commands and fully relied on God. (vs. 1, 5-7, 15-16)
- God provides saving power and sustaining power through the Ark.
- God provided for Noah's deliverance with the same means God destroyed the earth with. (vs. 16-24)
- The same water that destroyed the earth rose the Ark high above the earth. (vs. 17-19)
- God fulfills His Word/the promise He made to Noah. (Gen. 8:1)

Action point 2: See Jesus for yourself in the Ark and each book of the Bible. (1 Peter 3:18-22)

Now What: 1 - Put your faith in the Ark of Jesus.
