**Title: Cutting the Covenant**

**Scripture: Genesis 15**

**2026 Theme Verses** *May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God. **Romans 15:5-7***

**May Verse:** *I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed. **Gen. 12:3***

Remember that God performs CPR:

1. Coming Down God
  2. Promise making and promise keeping God
  3. Redeeming God

- 1) God answers fear with His presence. (vs. 1, 4)
    - a) The Word of the Lord comes to us.
  - 2) God answers perplexity with His promise. (vs. 1, 5)
    - a) God repeats, clarifies, and expands the promise. (He is the very great reward: Gen.12:2-3, 7; 13:16-17)
  - 3) God answers belief with His righteousness. (v. 6)
    - a) We are saved by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone according to Scripture alone for the glory of God alone. (Romans 4:9, 4:22; Gal. 3:6; James 2:23; Titus 3:8)
  - 4) God answers longing with His covenant. (vs. 7-20)
    - a) God's covenant is unilateral, uncontingent, and unconditional.

Will you depend on God's presence?

Will you desire God's promise of provision?

Will you delight in God's righteousness?

Will you decide to enter into the covenant with God?
