Guiding Plumblines #5 Excellence matters. Simplicity multiplies.

a. We pursue excellence without creating systems too complex to reproduce.

1. God fulfills His promises to everyone at all times. See them, count them, look for Jesus, and pass them on. (Gen. 25:1-11; Gen. 12:3)
2. Original Sin (the Sin Nature) is passed down from Adam. See it and break it by calling on the name of the LORD in salvation. (Romans 5:12, 15-17; 1 John 1:8-9)
3. Chosen Sin (sin habits) are learned from both our parents and the world around us. See them, confess them, and overcome them by believing the gospel and relying on the power of the Holy Spirit. (1 John 5:1-5; Gen. 25:12-26:15; 1 John 2:1-6)
4. Spiritual resources are like wells we can enjoy abundantly if we form spiritual habits around them and pass them on. If we abandon them we are doomed to make life bitter and pass that on. (Gen. 26:17-35; Isaiah 12:3; John 14:4)
