Title: More Than Conquerors Through Him Who Loved Us

Scripture: Romans 8:31-39

Sept. Scripture Memory: Romans 8:1, 28 or ALL of Romans 8

Five Questions more the Conquerors through Christ live by:

1. If God is for us, why would we fear any opposition? (v. 31)
2. If God saved us through His most precious and beloved Son, why would we worry about any need as His precious beloved sons? (v. 32)
 - a. He has already given us the Holy Spirit. (Eph. 1:13-14; Romans 5:5; 2 Cor. 5:5; 1 John 4:13; 1 Cor. 12:13)
3. If God accepts us, why would we fear anyone's accusations? (v. 33)
4. If Jesus was judged in our place, why would we fear anyone's condemnation? (v. 34)
 - a. Jesus is interceding for us.
5. If we cannot be separated from the love of God in Christ, why do we fear suffering? (vs. 35-39)
 - a. Suffering does not mean God has forgotten us. Suffering means God knows His love is more than enough to sustain us.

To live by faith is to live as more than conquerors through God who loves us.
