Ephesians 6:4 NLT

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, *bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord*.

Follow God <u>first</u>—others will follow you

Proverbs 20:7 NLT

The godly walk with integrity; *blessed are their children who follow them*.

Just show up—your <u>presence</u> is <u>powerful</u>

Colossians 3:23-24 NLT

Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

Little things done for <u>God</u> last <u>forever</u>

Psalm 127:3-5 NLT

Children are a gift from the Lord; they are a reward from him. Children born to a young man are like arrows in a warrior's hands. How joyful is the man whose quiver is full of them!

You shape the <u>future</u> by who you <u>love today</u>

Psalm 103:17-18 NLT

What stands out most to you from these verses—and how do they speak to your role right now?

- 4. Which part of Sunday's message hit home the most? Was it about presence, faithfulness in the ordinary, or shaping the next generation? Why?
- 5. What's one small step you can take this week to invest in someone else's future?

Think about a child, student, friend, or someone you lead. How could you speak life or give time this week?
