Big Rocks (Week 3)

Matthew 6:33-34

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Matthew 14:22-32

Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray.

Life makes it hard for us to maintain FOCUS.

Matthew 14:22-32 cont.

Later that night, he was there alone, and the boat was already a considerable distance from land, buffeted by the waves because the wind was against it. Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake.

Life is full of WND and WAVES.

Matthew 14:22-32 cont.

When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," they said, and cried out in fear. But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."

Fear cannot EXIST in the PRESENCE of God!

Matthew 14:22-32 cont.

"Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus.

But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!"

<u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> will <u>CONSUME</u> us if they are the focus.

Matthew 14:22-32 cont.

Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down.

God is not **BOTHERED** by your **MESS**.

Matthew 14:22-32 cont.

Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."

His <u>KINGDOM</u> and HIS <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> are all that matter!

- 2. Share a time you were so frustrated and tired that you just wanted to sit down and quit... or cry. We all respond differently!

- 4. Is there something that we can pray for you about this week? Take time to share and pray for one another.

- Looking at Matthew 13-16, Jesus is deep in the middle of his ministry and teaching on earth. If you were to try and communicate what was happening and what He was teaching from this text (to someone who's never heard any of this)... how would you summarize it?
