The Law: Confidence, Not Complaint

- Most of us take a dim view of the Law because we don't like restrictions placed on our freedom
- The Law is God's kindness made plain and graspable: here's what will keep you safe and alive and free

- Just as God's love gave us the gospel, God's love gave us the Law
- Deuteronomy 6:20, 24 NLT

 "In the future your children will ask you, 'What is the meaning of these laws, decrees, and regulations that the LORD our God has commanded us to obey?' ²⁴ And the Lord our God commanded us to obey all these decrees and to fear him so he can continue to bless us and preserve our lives, as he has done to this day."

Matthew 5:17-19 THE MESSAGE

"Don't suppose for a minute that I have come to demolish the Scriptures—either God's Law or the Prophets. I'm not here to demolish but to complete. I am going to put it all together, pull it all together in a vast panorama. God's Law is more real and lasting than the stars in the sky and the ground at your feet. Long after stars burn out and earth wears out, God's Law will be alive and working. Trivialize even the smallest item in God's Law and you will only have trivialized yourself. But take it seriously, show the way for others, and you will find honor in the kingdom."

"Great sorrow awaits you religious scholars and Pharisees—frauds and pretenders! All Religious Rules are Not Equal

- The Law is lovely, Jesus shows us, but human religious rules are the stench of death
- Mark 7:8 NIV
 "You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions."
- Consider Colossians 2:16-23, where Paul tells us not to let anyone steal away our real life in Christ for the false unlife of rules, regulations, and requirements

All Religious Rules are Not Equal

- Don't let anyone put the chains of legalism on you and cancel your liberty in Christ
- Matthew 11:28-30 MSG
 - "Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with me and work with me—watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly."

Two Ways to Know Who You Are

- One is by rule-keeping and performance. Not only will you know where you stand but you'll be able to tell who's in and who's out
- The other is this: we were made to know ourselves solely in the reality of being chosen and loved by God

Safe, Alive, Free

- Steve Brown's advice in A Scandalous Freedom: live your life with such freedom and joy that uptight Christians will doubt your salvation
- It's a way of being that happens within the boundary markers of God's law, which will keep us safe and alive and free
- That's because the Law is an expression of his love
