THE BIBLE ON MONEY

- In the gospels, an amazing one out of ten verses (288 in all) deal directly with the subject of money
- There are more than 2,300 verses on money, possessions, and wealth in the Bible
- Jesus spoke about money in roughly 15% of his preaching and 11 out of 39 parables



THE BIBLE ON MONEY

Some folks think money is irrelevant to their character, doesn't have any connection to their Christianity

 Almost every New Testament list of leadership
qualifications mentions money (1 Peter 5:2; Titus 1:7; 1 Timothy 3:2-3)
