Try Thankfulness: God Enjoys Receiving It

Luke 17:17-18 Jesus asked, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?” NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION

Try Thankfulness: It Guards Our Hearts

Philippians 4:7 “And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.” NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION

The word Paul uses (PHROUREIN) is the military word for standing on guard; this is a peace that aggressively defends the heart from everything that would seek to discourage it
