## A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

 Cultivate: to prepare and work on (land) in order to raise crops [dictionary.com]



#### 1 CORINTHIANS 3:6-9

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. 7 So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. 8 The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor. 9 For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building.





- Note where Paul draws our attention: "So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow" [v. 7]
- Paul isn't suggesting that what we do does not matter, nor that, in the Father's eyes, He is everything and we are nothing

- Paul's statement is a relative one: from the macro view of ultimate reality, God is the first and the last and everything in between
- Paul wants us to understand that as vital as our part is, we can claim no credit for anything that results from our efforts at cultivating

#### **MATTHEW 11:28-30**

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

#### THE PRESSURE FOR RESULTS

- The pressure we put on ourselves, the weight of this responsibility for results, causes us to become, in our disappointment and impatience, accusers—of others, ourselves, and God
- We instinctively look for causality; we naturally want to assign blame for meager or missing results

#### UNEXPECTED

- In the midst of cultivating, as we work toward a desired result, something's happening we aren't looking for: something in us
- Paul tells us, as we are working alongside the Father, "You are God's field" [1 Cor. 3:9]
- We are workers in the field, eager for a kingdom harvest, and simultaneously we are the field God is cultivating

- Galatians 6:9 NIV

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.
