• Amos said, in essence, "This is not the life I was looking for."


- He doesn't do it off the cuff or on a whim

- The anonymous nobodies of the world are the ones God goes after as he seeks out a people who will rise to the occasion of his heart for world
- I wouldn't do it that way. Neither would you.
- It's also true none of us can create and reveal a quasar nearly 13 billion light-years from Earth
- To our surprise (but rarely our satisfaction), we, the anonymous nobodies, are God's plan A and B and C

• Luke 10:2-3 NIV

- What's the answer to their prayer? They are.
- The point: the solution will not come apart from their participation

• Psalm 121:1-2 NIV

"I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from? ² My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth."

- God isn't going to magically resolve everything while we sit back and coach him on how best to bring our deliverance
- We're going to get our hands dirty. And our hearts broken

How Will We Respond to God's Call?

- Jeremiah 1:6 NLT
 - "O Sovereign Lord," I said, "I can't speak for you! I'm too young!"
- Exodus 4:1 MESSAGE
 Moses objected, "They won't trust me. They won't listen to a word I say. They're going to say, 'God? Appear to him? Hardly!"
- 2 Corinthians 2:16b NLT
 "And who is adequate for such a task as this?"

How Will We Respond to God's Call?

- No matter our rationale for objecting—fear, insecurity, disinterest—if God has determined to have us, have us He will
- He'll take us the easiest way we'll go, so the question is: which way will we go?
- Don't confuse your reluctance, your "lack of peace" with an indication that it must not be God
- Pray a counter-intuitive affirmation: "<u>I'm</u> the one God's going to use to bring breakthrough. For WMC. For my family. It's what he does and who he is."

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
