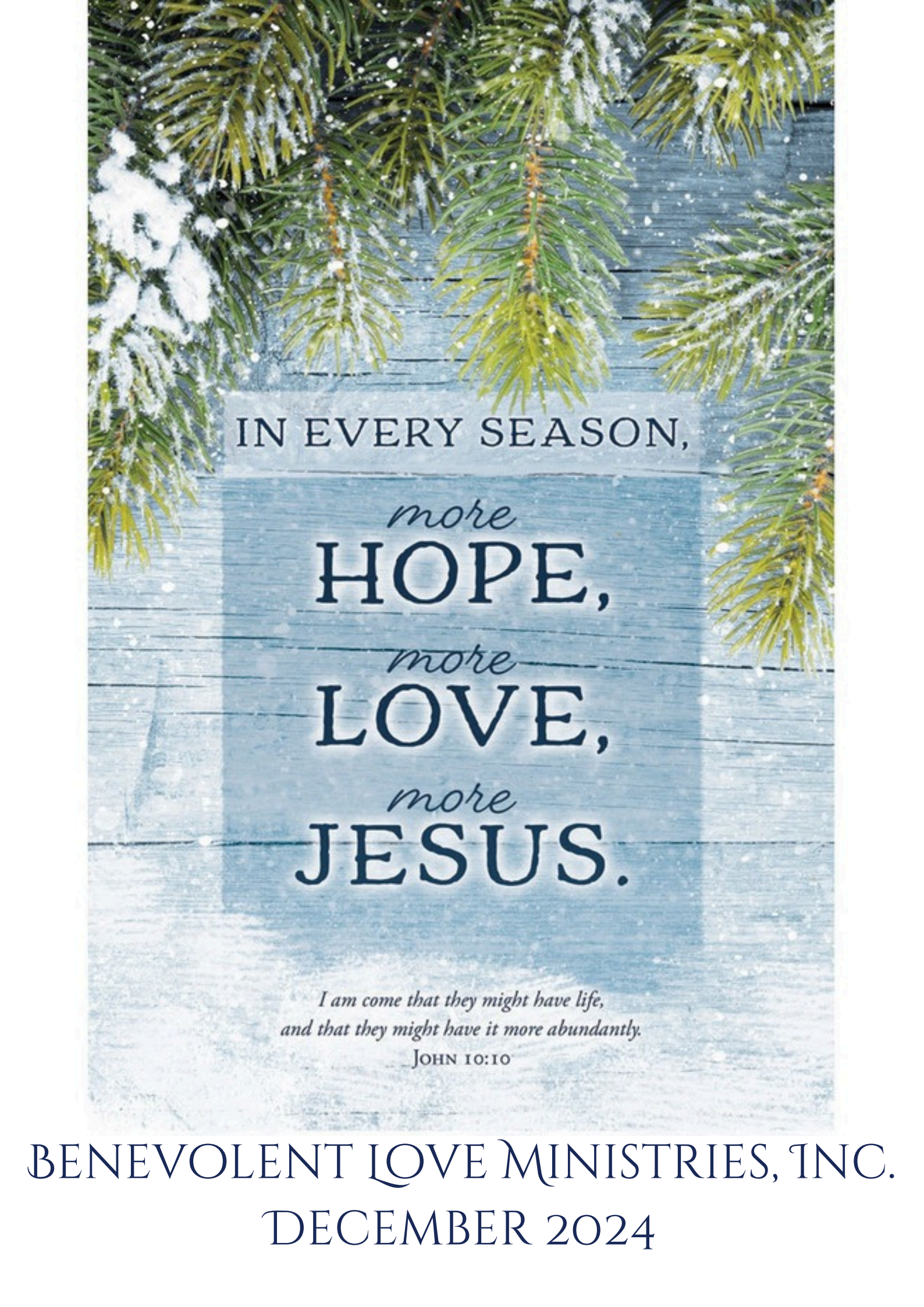

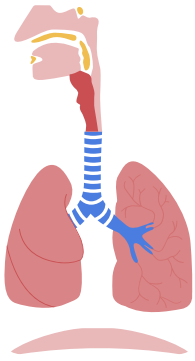

A Benevolent Health Department Note

A special educational health note from our Health Department on: Respiratory Illnesses & our precautions for our church family.

As always, check with your personal healthcare team for your full health needs.

Respiratory Illnesses & Special Medical Conditions



Respiratory illnesses directly impact the nose, mouth, throat, and lung areas. Respiratory illnesses include colds, flus, RSV, and Covid.



People with special medical and health conditions should be extra careful during big respiratory illnesses seasons. Talk with your healthcare provider for more specifics, but we recommend you inform the Ushers to sit in a special area, and wear a mask to protect yourself.

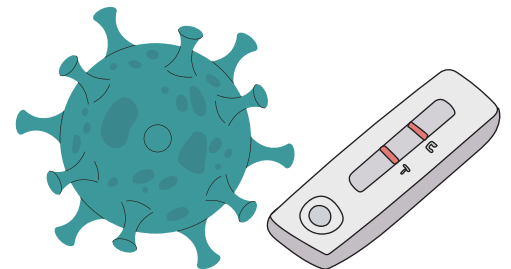
Let's limit the spread and protect each other!



Wash your hands with soap and warm water. Sing "Happy Birthday" and you'll have washed for a good amount of time!



Stay away from others when you're sick, and wear a mask if you must go around others.



If you have COVID, you must:

- stay away from others while you have symptoms & fever (stay home if possible)
- after symptoms & fever have been gone for 24 hours, you will wear a mask around others for 5 days.



Cover your coughs and sneezes.



Throw away tissues and cloths used for your nose or mouth.



Ask your healthcare team about other options to prevent and treat respiratory illnesses.
