Wisdom





1. Wisdom begins with
the fear of the Lord



The fear of the Lord is the beginning of
wisdom, and the knowledge of the
Holy One is *understanding*.

Proverbs 9:10





Wisdom
begins with **SURRENDER**
not strategy.

Wisdom
begins with
bowing before God,

not building on
your own strength.





The *wise woman* acknowledges:



God knows more than she does



God sees further than she can



God understands what she cannot

Her wisdom isn't in her plan—it is in
her *posture*.






Wisdom is the
fruit of relationship.









This relationship requires
connection, not just information.





Knowledge in Hebrew is *da'at* which is derived from the root verb *yada*.

-  It means experiential intimacy
 -  It is practical and relational, not theoretical
 -  It involves active observation and care
 -  It grows over time
 -  It reflects the source

2. Jesus Defines *the Wise Builder*



24 “Therefore, whoever *hears* these sayings of Mine, and *does* them,
I will liken him to a *wise* man who built his house on the *rock*:

25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew
and beat on that house; and it *did not fall*, for it was founded on the rock.

26 “But everyone who *hears* these sayings of Mine, and *does not do* them,
will be like a *foolish* man who built his house on the *sand*:

27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew
and beat on that house; and *it fell*. And great was its fall.

◆ Matthew 7:24–27 ◆



... Jesus gives us *the blueprint:*



The wise woman *hears* His words and *does* them.



She builds on *rock*, not *sand*.



When — *not if* — the rain falls,
the floods rise, and the winds beat against
her life, her house *stands*.



.... A wise woman
builds her life on
obedience to the *Word of God.*



- ✘ Not on *feelings*
- ✘ Not on *trends*
- ✘ Not on what *culture* applauds
- ✘ Not on what is *convenient*





Jesus doesn't
promise a
storm-free life.



He promises a
collapse-proof one.





Godly Wisdom is
obedience in action.





3. A Wise Woman *Builds* with *God's Wisdom,* Not Her Own



“If any of you lacks wisdom,
let him ask of God... and it
will be given to him.”

—◆ *James 1:5* ◆—





God is not like us ...



He *invites* you to *ask*.
He *delights* in giving *wisdom*.
He never rebukes a woman
for needing *wisdom*—
He only rebukes the woman
who *refuses* to seek it.





James 1:5 gives *every woman hope:*



- ✿ No matter *your past*
- ✿ No matter *your mistakes*
- ✿ No matter *your starting point*

You can begin *building wisely* today.





Wisdom is not
self-generated.



Wisdom is
God-given.





4. A Wise Woman *Builds With God,* Not Apart From Him
