The Hebrew word for
house is *bayith*.



- A household or family



- A lineage or legacy



- A spiritual environment



- A place of belonging and influence



- Even a dynasty or generational line





A wise woman builds her *house* means she is actively shaping:



- The **spiritual direction** of her family



- The **emotional atmosphere** of her home



- The **patterns** that will be repeated by the next generation





She is *building*:



A *spiritual* environment



A *pattern* of living



A *culture* of truth



A *legacy* that will outlive her

is energetic service to God
and others, marked by
discipline and *focus*.

She *fills* her heart with truth.

She *teaches* it intentionally.

She *lives* it daily.

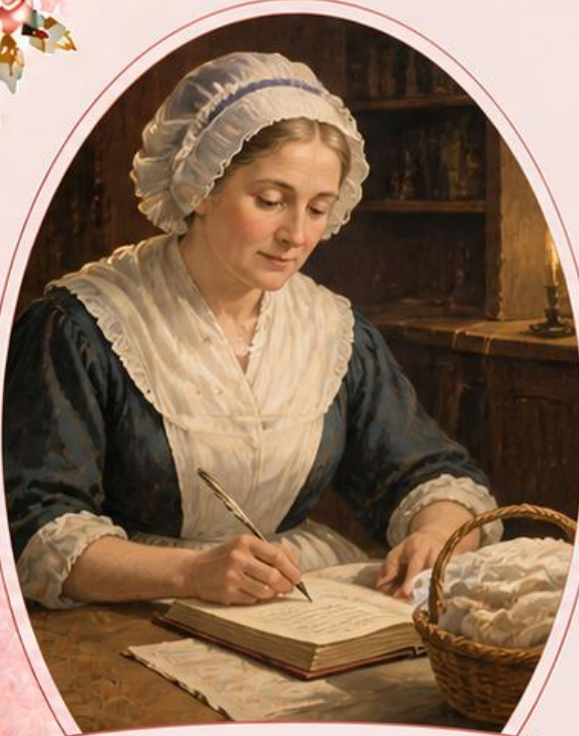
She *repeats* it consistently.

The Testimony of *Susanna Wesley*




Her legacy was built
under an apron.

A mother who invested in *eternity*
through the *ordinary*.

- ❖ She rose early to *pray*.
 - ❖ She taught her children *God's Word*.
 - ❖ She trained their *hearts*, not just their minds.
 - ❖ She *lived out* what she taught.
 - ❖ She *repeated* truth until it became their life.

Her legacy produced more than 100 ministers,
including her sons *John* and *Charles* Wesley.

She *hid him* three months...

But when she could
no longer *hide him*...

she took an *ark*
of *bulrushes*...
and placed the *child* in it.
