- 1. We need authentic relationships with brothers and sisters in Christ because:
 - A. They are necessary for our spiritual growth and maturity. (Ephesians 4:11-13)
 - Spiritual maturity equals <u>Christ-likeness</u>.
 - God desires to use hard and messy relationships with brothers and sisters in Christ to mature us.
 - B. We need others to speak the <u>truth</u> in <u>love</u> to us. (Ephesians 4:14-15)
 - This is necessary because...
 - 1. We are easily deceived.
 - 2. We all have blind spots.
 - C. You have something to offer others. (Ephesians 4:16)
 - Be a contributor, not a consumer.

Conclusion: Living without authentic relationships with brothers and sisters in Christ is <u>foolish</u>, <u>dangerous</u>, and will stunt your spiritual growth.
