For Discussion:

- 1. What are the consequences and ramifications of jealousy?
- 2. What is at the root of jealousy? What does jealousy reveal?
- 3. How does the gospel help root jealousy out of our hearts?
- 4. Read 1 Samuel 18-20.
 - 1 Samuel 19:9 says, "An evil spirit from the Lord..." Why would God send an evil spirit to Saul?
 - How did Saul's sin of jealousy impact others, specifically Jonathan and David?
 - Jonathan was probably hoping to replace Saul as the next king of Israel. So, why was Jonathan not jealous of David?

Response & Application:

- 1. Share about jealousy in your life with three or four people in a group.
- 2. How do the four steps to dealing with jealousy from the message relate to you?
 - Recognize jealousy reveals the deepest loves of our hearts. (1 Samuel 18)
 - Confess, repent, and pray for God to purify our hearts. (James 4:8)
 - Believe Christ is all you need for contentment and joy. (Philippians 4:11-13)
 - Embrace the gospel. (1 John 4:9-10)
