#### Let your light shine by:

#### 1. Avoiding <a href="https://hypocrisy.com/hypocrisy">hypocrisy</a>. (Luke 12:1-3)

"Hypocrisy means playing a part, engaging in pretense. It demands conscious insincerity. It is a character sin, a moral deficiency."

#### 2. Fearing God, not man. (Luke 12:4-12)

"This means following Jesus is not a matter of our convenience, popularity, or man's approval. We're to follow Jesus no matter the cost and trust that he will reward us when men reject us."
