1. Be encouraged- the Holy Spirit works despite our issues and conflicts. (Acts 15:36-41)

4. Be encouraged- the Holy Spirit works despite <u>opposition</u> and <u>suffering</u>. (Acts 16:16-34)

5. Be encouraged- the <u>Holy Spirit</u> works in the lives of the wealthy, poor, and working class. (Acts 16:22-34)
