## **Science and Religion:**

- According to the National Academy of Sciences:
  - <u>Science</u> relies on empirical evidence and testable explanations that are independent of the individual.
  - <u>Religion</u> relies on faith that can be deeply personal and beyond the testing with empirical data.
- By definition, science cannot confirm nor deny anything outside of the <u>physical</u> realm.
- Therefore, science cannot prove nor disprove the existence of God, but it does point to His existence.
- Often people misunderstand the nature of science.
- The idea that empirical data precludes the existence of anything outside of the physical universe cannot be empirically tested nor confirmed itself.
- It is a matter of faith to assume that there is no one or nothing outside of the physical realm.

#### Faith and Reason Are Not Exclusive:

"The Christian church doesn't believe what it does IN SPITE OF reason, but BECAUSE OF reason." ...always be prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you (1 Peter 3:15)... Christians must freely admit that no one can prove the existence of God scientifically. But scientific proof and logical plausibility are not interchangeable concepts."

## **God's Design is Clearly Evident:**

- When we examine the universe, we see tremendous clues, evidence of a Creator God. (Romans 1:20)
- Illustration: 19<sup>th</sup> century, William Paley's teleological argument for God. (Design of a watch)
- Cosmological Argument—the universe had a beginning.
   (Illustrated by energy)

Two options for the beginning of the universe

- 1. An outside agent
- 2. The universe spontaneously came into existence with no cause and no purpose.

- Additional evidence: the universe is finely tuned.
  - 1. The electromagnetic coupling constant
  - 2. Ratio of electron to proton mass
  - 3. The gravitational constant
- The beauty and the grandeur of the universe testifies to God's creative work. (Psalm 19:1-2)
- The detail and design of life testifies to God's creative work.
  - 1. Details of the cell (Kinesin Motor Proteins)
  - 2. Protein Synthesis
  - 3. DNA / Protein interdependency
  - 4. DNA and Histones

## Faith and Science are Compatible:

Science itself is actually based on some faith positions.

"[Many people] assume that Christianity is a blind leap in the dark... Faith is not, however, a leap. Rather, it is a foundation. All science is based upon a faith of some kind... In fact, the most basic assumption of the sciences is the uniformity of nature—the expectation that the present and future will be like the past. But none of these things are proved by natural science—they are believed on faith. It is because we believe these things that science itself is made a meaningful and intelligible discipline."
