A. The false prophet will...

1. Make everyone worship the Antichrist and his image.
(Revelation 13:12, 14-15)
2. Perform great miracles and signs. (Revelation 13:13, 15)
 - Call down fire from heaven
 - Breathe life into the image of the Antichrist
3. Deceive people throughout the earth.
(Revelation 13:14, 19:20)
4. Oversee the world's economic programs... the mark of the beast. (Revelation 13:16-18)

B. The mark of the beast will...

1. Allow you to buy and sell.
2. Be forced on the whole world.
(Revelation 13:16; 20:4)
3. Be for those who worship the Antichrist.
(Revelation 16:2, 19:20, 20:4)

C. Two witnesses will...

1. Prophecy for three and a half years. (Revelation 11:2-3)
2. Have supernatural power. (Revelation 11:6)
3. Be killed by the Antichrist. (Revelation 11:7-10)
4. Be resurrected and ascend into heaven.
(Revelation 11:11-13)

D. Application for us...

1. Beware of deception. (Matthew 24:24)
2. Fear God, not man. (Matthew 10:28)
3. Choose Jesus. (Matthew 12:30)

COMMUNION



WHAT IS IT?

Communion is a visible representation of the Good News of the death of Christ for our sins. It reminds us of Christ's death and the glorious hope of His return. The bread and wine symbolize Christ's Body and blood.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All who trust in Jesus Christ and Him alone for forgiveness of their sins are welcome to participate, regardless of church affiliation.

If this is not a step you have taken, here is the path to become a Christian.

- Romans 3:23 Admit you are a sinner.
- Romans 6:23 Recognize the penalty for your sin is death.
- Romans 5:8 Jesus Christ died for you.
- Romans 10:9-10 To be forgiven for your sins, you must believe and confess that Jesus was God who died for your sins and He is Lord.
- John 14:6 Salvation comes through Jesus Christ and Him alone.



For I received from the Lord what I also passed on to you: The Lord Jesus, on the night he was betrayed, took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me." For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

- Partake
- Return to your seat

- Romans 5:1-2, 8:31-39

3. Praising God Through Singing

- "Calvary"
- "I Speak Jesus"
- "Death Was Arrested"
