Why does church need to be more than a Sunday service?

1. **Because we are a spiritual family.** (John 1:12; Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 5:1-2)

- God's vision for the church is a family.
- All families are dysfunctional.

"Each church is family. Not only should we understand that the church in general is family, but also that each particular church is family: both in what it is (by definition) and what it must be (by calling). We are to view each other as family and we are to treat each other as family. In other words, we should care for each other as if we were, in fact, 'blood.'" -John N. Day

2. **Because we are blinded to our sin and issues.**
(Hebrews 3:12-13; Galatians 6:1)

- We need to invite others to speak into our lives.

(Galatians 6:2-3)

- We were created to need God and others.
- Self-sufficiency is pride.

4. Because all of us need spiritual encouragement.

(Hebrews 10:24-25)

- Our natural drift is towards self—not God.

5. Because we all have something to offer.

(1 Corinthians 12:21-24)

- Self-centered motives sabotage relationships.
- Be a contributor, not a consumer.
